What is GuidedPath?

0:05 In our GuidedPath program we have classes laid out with a specific curriculum, it's somewhat calendar driven, it has a schedule, it keeps learners on track and on pace to a successful completion over a number of weeks during that course. *(Laura Sankovich – Faculty)*
