

Official Transcript: GuidedPath vs. FlexPath—What you need to know

SPEAKER, MAYBETH MOSES: With FlexPath, *(title card on screen: Maybeth Moses, Capella Graduate)* you're creating the deadlines, you're doing all the work at your own pace *(On screen disclaimer: Actual graduates, faculty, and staff who agreed to be featured in Capella promotional materials)*. In Guided, you have to complete discussion postings by specific days of the week. You have to have your responses done by specific days of the week. You have assignments that you're turning in, that are due on a specific date. So it's more structured.

SPEAKER, DIANE DAYSON: *(title card on screen: Diane Dayson, Faculty, School of Nursing and Health Sciences)* Oftentimes learners need structure and so GuidedPath affords them the opportunity. Whereas FlexPath is for that learner who is really energetic and motivated and determined and knows exactly what they want and know that they can move forward and at their own pace and feel comfortable doing that.

SPEAKER, PHIL MOLLING: *(title card on screen: Phil Molling, Enrollment Services)* The GuidedPath or the FlexPath is really the format, the vehicle in which you choose to get there. The skills that you're acquiring, the competencies that you're polishing throughout the program, those are going to be the same. And even when you graduate, I mean, the outcome is going to be the same. You're going to be a polished, competent individual, in the field of study that you're moving towards.
